The Falkenberg Foundation does not plan to have any fundraising activities.

PART II. Activities and Operational Information

The Falkenberg Foundation was incorporated under the laws of the state of Colorado on April 14, 1993. The Falkenberg Foundation has accepted gifts in the aggregate amount of \$109,041.13 from William and Janis Falkenberg. The Foundation held its funds in a non-interest bearing account until June 5, 1994. On June 5, 1994, the Foundation invested \$100,000 of such funds in a Linsco Private Ledger Strategic Asset Management account, with the balance remaining in the Foundation's non-interest bearing account. The funds in the Strategic Asset Management fund will be invested in cash or cash equivalents, stocks, bonds and mutual funds. The anticipated return on the Strategic Asset Management account for 1994 and 1995 is 7.00% on an annual basis.

Through May 31, 1994, the Falkenberg Foundation has made gifts in the aggregate amount of \$6,325.00 to various qualifying organizations which support and promote religious, charitable, scientific, literary, educational, cultural and historical activities, which gifts are described with particularity on the attached Exhibit 1.

In the current year and in future years, the Falkenberg Foundation will disburse all of the net income from the above referenced Strategic Asset Management Account and from any other sources to various qualifying organizations which support and promote religious, charitable, scientific, literary, educational, cultural and historical activities. Distributions to qualifying organizations will be made annually after a meeting and vote of the Falkenberg Foundation's Board of Directors.

FALKENBERG FOUNDATION

The undersigned, acting as incorporator of a corporation under the Colorado Nonprofit Corporation Act, adopts the following Articles of Incorporation for such corporation.

ARTICLE I.

The name of the corporation is Falkenberg Foundation.

ARTICLE II.

The period of its duration shall be perpetual.

ARTICLE III.

The corporation is organized exclusively for charitable, scientific, literary or educational purposes within the meaning of and pursuant to section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 (or under the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue law). References in these Articles of Incorporation to the "Code" shall be to the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended from time to time.

ARTICLE IV.

A. No part of the income or net earnings of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to, any member, director or officer of the corporation or any other private individual (except that reasonable compensation may be paid for services rendered to or for the corporation affecting one or more of its purposes, and reimbursement may be made for any expenses incurred for the corporation by any officer,

director, agent or employee, or any other person or corporation, pursuant to and upon authorization of the Board of Directors); and provided further that no member, director or officer of the corporation, or any other private individual shall be entitled to share in any distribution of any of the corporate assets on dissolution of the corporation or otherwise. No substantial part of the activities of the corporation shall consist of carrying on propaganda or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, except as otherwise provided in section 501(h) of the Code. The corporation shall not participate in or intervene in (including the publishing or distributing of statements) any political campaign on behalf of, or in opposition to, any candidate for public office.

- B. No part of the assets of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of or be distributable to any organization whose income or net earnings or any part thereof inure to the benefit of any private shareholder or other individual or any substantial part of the activities of which consists of carrying on propaganda or otherwise attempting to influence legislation.
- c. Upon dissolution of the corporation, all of its assets shall be paid over or transferred to one or more exempt organizations of the kind described in section 501(c)(3) of the Code.
- D. Notwithstanding any other provision hereof, this corporation shall not conduct or carry on any activities not permitted to be conducted or carried on by an organization which

is tax exempt under the provisions of section 501(c)(3) of the Code.

Articles during any period that the corporation is a "private foundation" within the meaning of section 509 of the Code, the corporation shall be required to distribute its income for each taxable year of the corporation at such time and in such manner as not to subject the corporation to tax under section 4942 of the Code; and the corporation shall be prohibited from engaging in any act of self-dealing as defined in section 4941(d) of the Code, from retaining any excess business holdings in violation of the provisions of section 4943(c) of the Code, from making any investments in such manner as to subject the corporation to tax under section 4944 of the Code, and from making any taxable expenditures as defined in section 4945(d) of the Code.

ARTICLE V.

The corporation shall have no members and all business affairs of the corporation shall be conducted by its Board of Directors.

ARTICLE VI.

The address of the initial registered office of the corporation is 430 Marion Street, Denver, Colorado 80218, and the name of its initial registered agent at such address is William S. Falkenberg.

ARTICLE VII.

Elimination of Certain Liabilities of Directors

There shall be no personal liability, either direct or indirect, of any director of the corporation to the corporation or to its members for monetary damages for any breach or breaches of fiduciary duty as a director; except that this provision shall not eliminate the liability of a director to the corporation or to its members for monetary damages for any breach, act, omission or transaction as to which the Colorado Nonprofit Corporation Act (as in effect from time to time) prohibits expressly the elimination of liability. This provision is in the corporation's original Articles of Incorporation and thus is effective on the date of the corporation's incorporation. This provision shall not limit the rights of directors of the corporation for indemnification or other assistance from the corporation. This provision shall not restrict or otherwise diminish the provisions of Section 13-21-116(2)(b), Colorado Revised Statutes (concerning no liability of directors except for wanton and willful acts or omissions), any amendment or successor provision to such Section, or any other law limiting or eliminating liabilities. Any repeal or modification of the foregoing provisions of this Article by the members of the corporation or any repeal or modification of the provision of the Colorado Nonprofit Corporation Act which permits the elimination of liability of directors by this Article shall not affect adversely any elimination of liability, right or protection of a director of the corporation with respect to any

breach, act, omission, or transaction of such director occurring prior to the time of such repeal or modification.

ARTICLE VIII.
